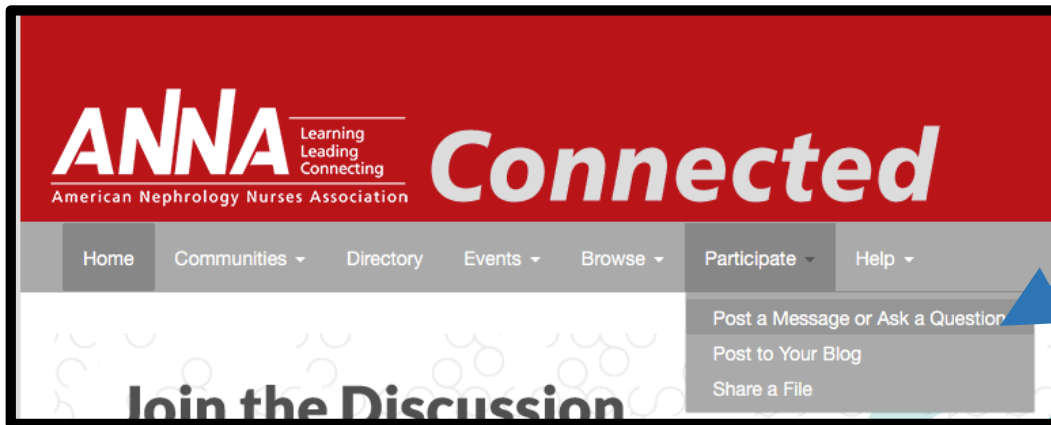


Posting a Message or Starting a New Thread

You can reply to a message from your phone. Simply click on "Reply to Group."

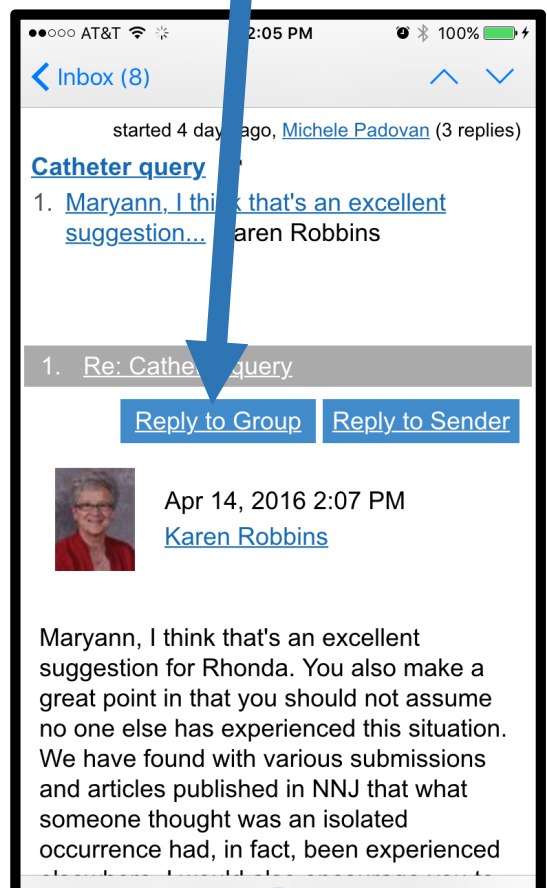
